




# Add unlimited Joomla and WordPress sites to mySites.guru

Step-by-step guide to connecting your first Joomla or WordPress site to mySites.guru - supports unlimited sites for one flat monthly fee.

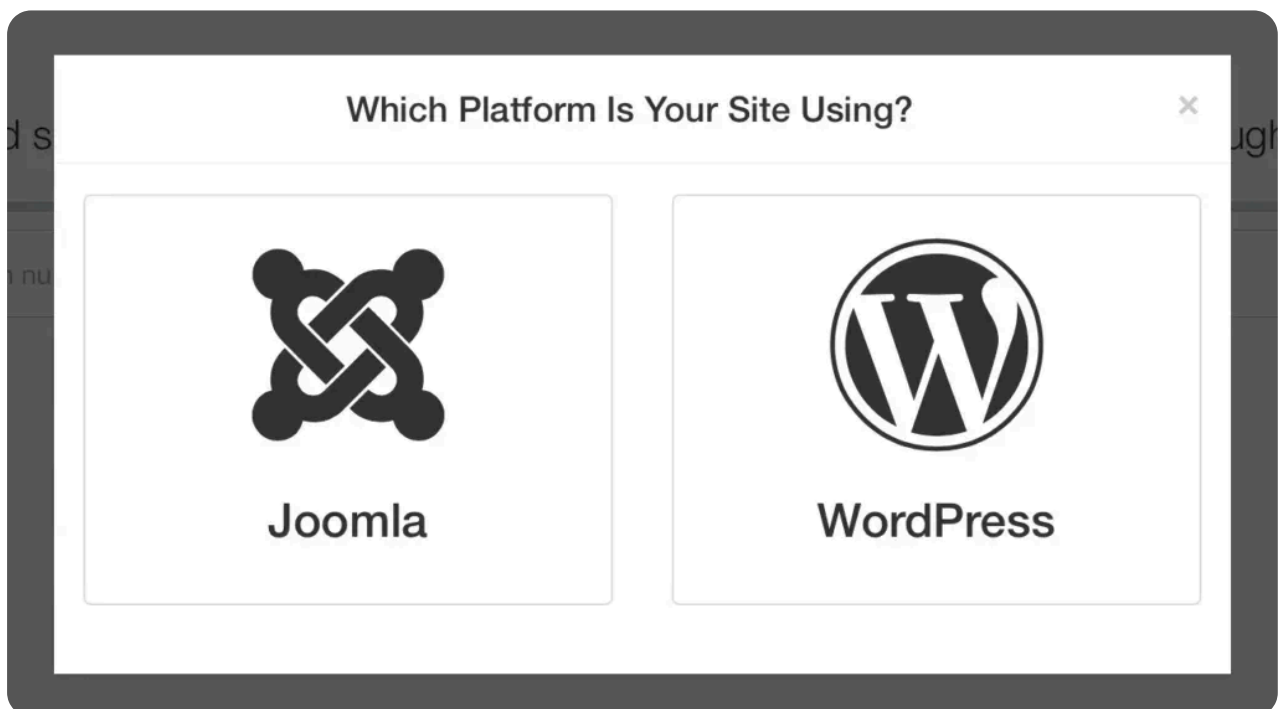
 The screenshots below are from an older version of the interface. We've since redesigned the dashboard, but the process works the same way.

One of the founding principles of mySites.guru is that we offer an **unlimited service** for **unlimited sites** in your account at one set price per month (or year).

We haven't raised prices once since we launched in 2012. Fourteen years later and it's still the same flat fee - no sneaky annual increases, no "new tier" upsells.

Once you have created your account at mySites.guru, you can then add your first site!


Adding your first site is straightforward - select which platform you want to connect. We support all Joomla versions from 1.5 upwards and WordPress going back a long time.

You will then be presented with the connection wizard.

## How do you add a Joomla site to mySites.guru?

Before we can connect to your site, we will need you to install our connector on your site.

We have made this very easy for you! You can install it just like any other plugin/extension.

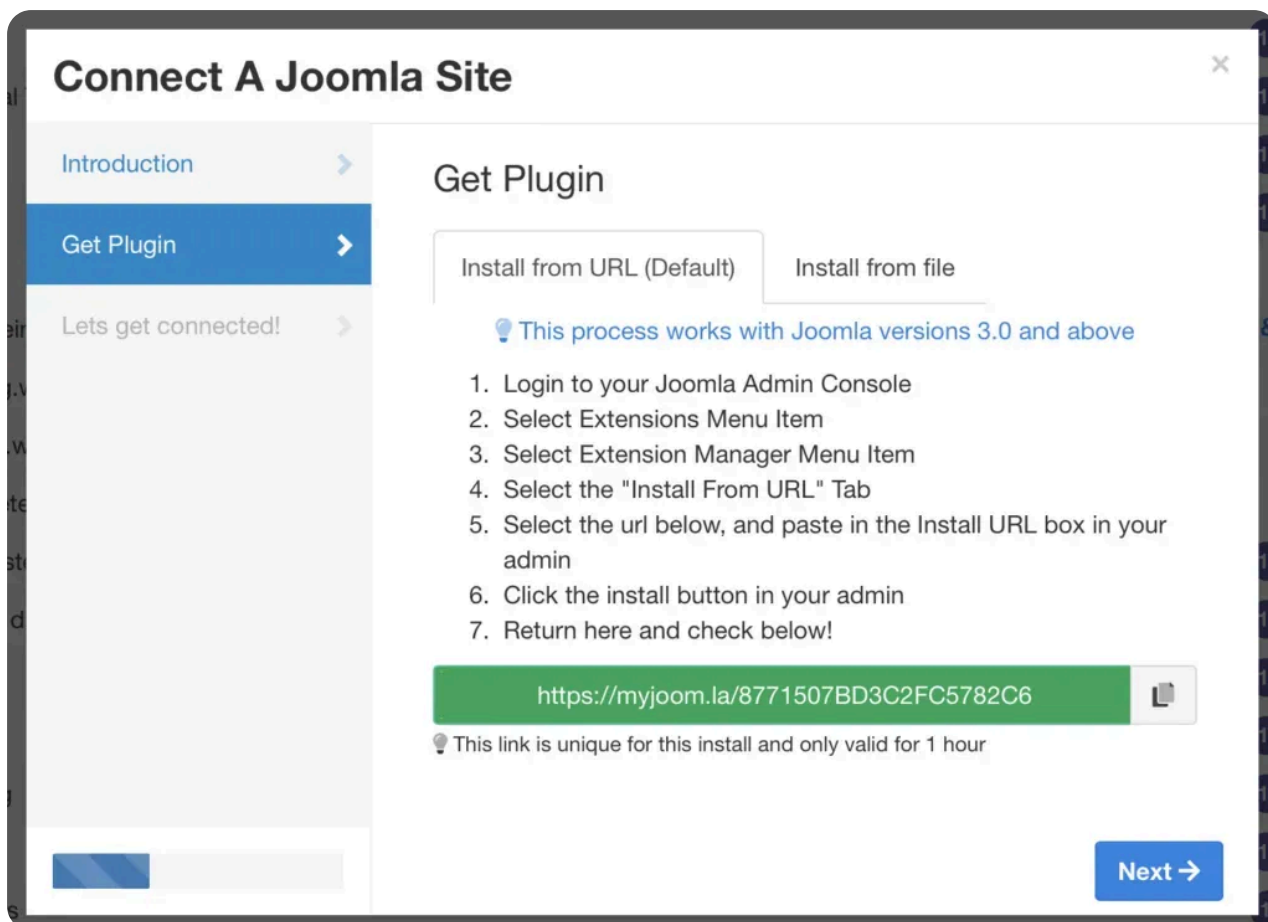
**Every connector is unique and contains a unique set of keys** that encrypt the data to and from your site with industry standard encryption. If your site uses SSL, then we will connect over SSL too.

We use standard internet ports 80 (or 443 for https:// sites) and use a [documented set of IP addresses](#)

**Every request we send has to be validated by us before code is run.**

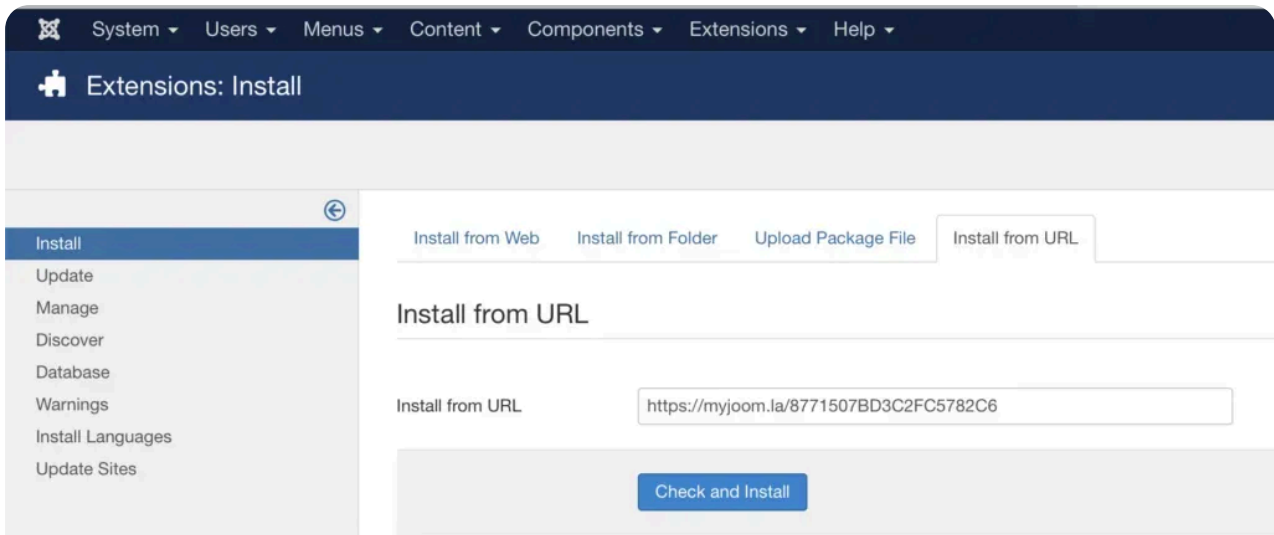
At the bottom right of the main content area is a blue button labeled "Next →".

After clicking the Joomla logo you will see the connection wizard, take a look, read, and then you can proceed to the next page.



On the "Get Plugin" page you are given two different ways to install our plugin into your Joomla Site.

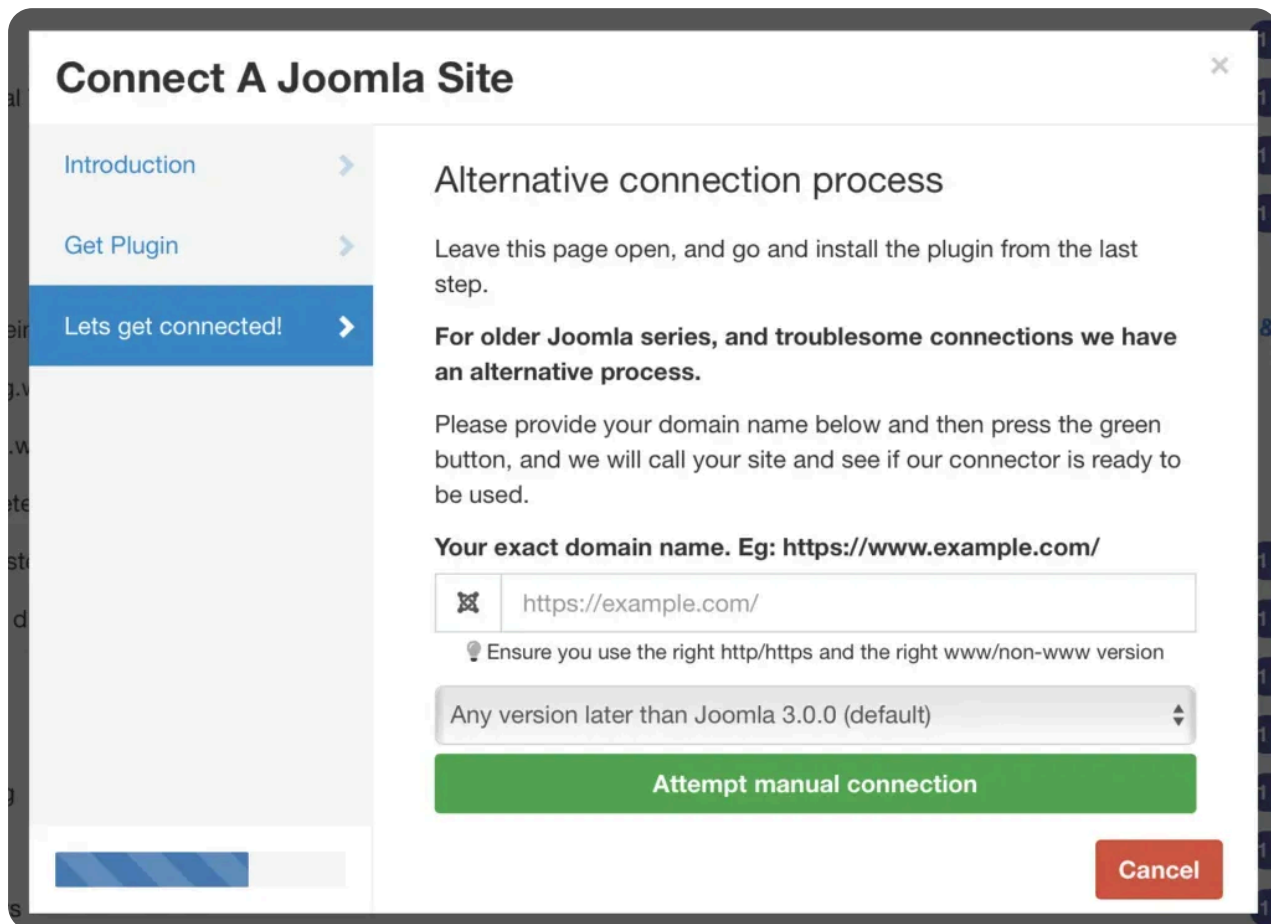
The most simple is to just copy the url in the green box by pressing the copy button next to it, and paste that into the [Joomla Extension](#) Installer in your sites admin console.



After clicking check and install and seeing a green success message, return to mySites.guru where you will see a connected screen - and your site will be connected! or you will see this screen:



Dont panic if you see this, it just means your site did not call home to us - we can try to shout at your site and see if our connector is listening, to do this click the "click here" on this screen to provide your domain name



Add your domain name and attempt the manual connection - fingers crossed the next screen you will see is the manage site page and your site will be connected to mySites.guru

## How do you connect a WordPress site to mySites.guru?

The process for WordPress sites is slightly different. In the wizard you will be prompted to download our plugin zip. **Read the important notes.**

### Get Our Plugin

**⚠ The plugin you download is unique for this install and only valid for 1 hour**

1. Login to your Wordpress Admin Console
2. Select Plugins in the left menu
3. Select "Add New" next to the title of "Plugins"
4. Select Upload Plugin next to the title of "Add Plugins"
5. Download our connector using the button below

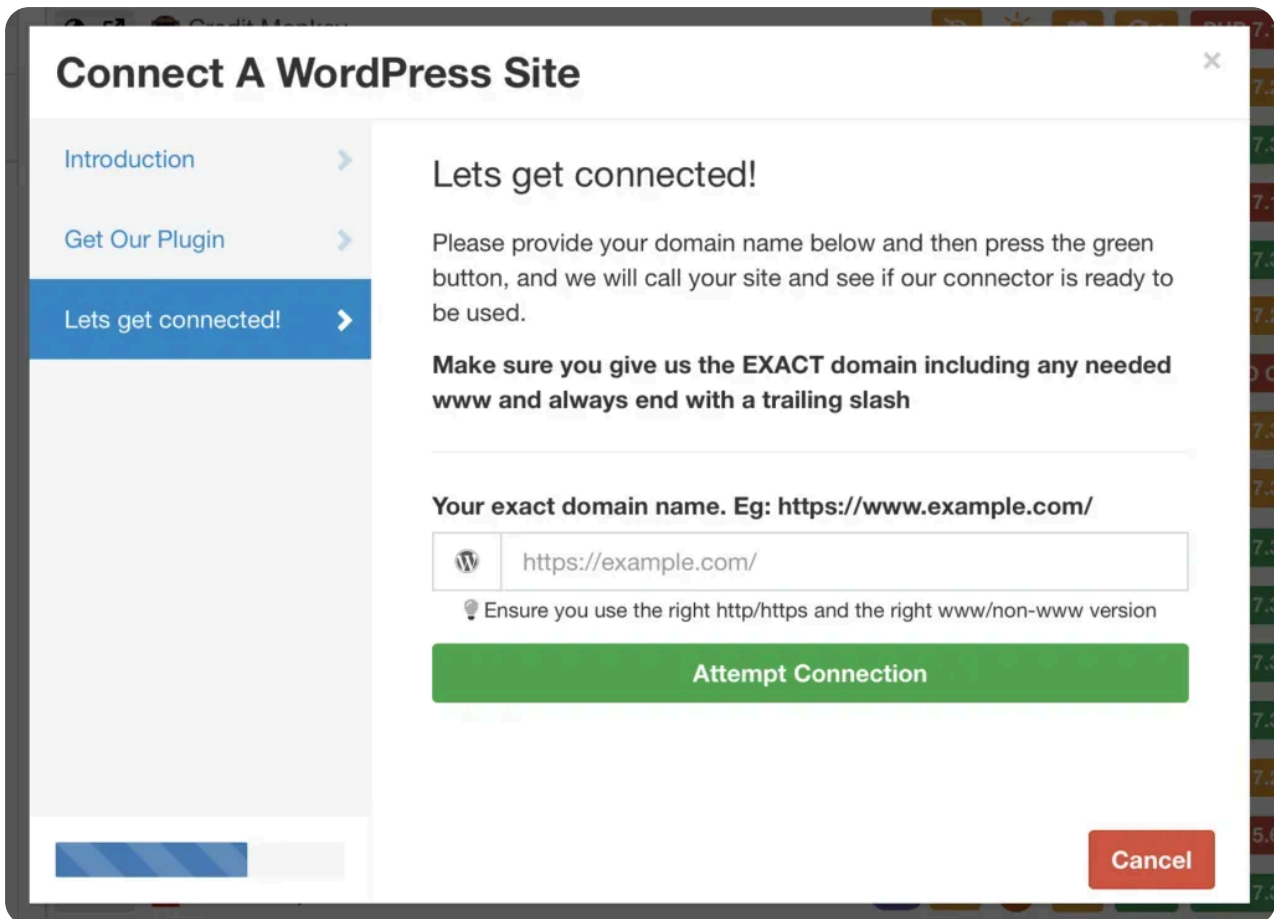

6. MAKE SURE OUR ZIP IS `mywpguru.zip` and not something else like `mywpguru (1).zip`, this happens if you have many in your downloads folder. The file name MUST be `mywpguru.zip` before you upload it to your site.
7. Select Choose File, and select our zip file you downloaded
8. Click Install Now button.
9. Click Activate Plugin link
10. Click Next button in the bottom of this wizard page

You can then install this WordPress plugin the same way you would upload any WordPress plugin to your site.

You will then be asked to provide us with your WordPress Site URL ending in a trailing slash



Once you click attempt connection, we will shout over to your WordPress site and see if our connector replies, and then redirect you to the WordPress Manage site page.

## Can I really connect unlimited sites for one set fee?

YES! - Currently the maximum number of sites in a single customer account is 750!

If you get near 750, let me know, I'll buy you a cake!

We have not increased our prices for subscriptions from the GBP19.99 per month since we launched in 2012.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **How many sites can I add to a single mySites.guru account?**

You can connect up to 750 sites on one account for a single flat monthly fee, with no per-site charges.

## **How do I connect a Joomla site to mySites.guru?**

After creating your account, use the connection wizard to copy a plugin URL and install it via the Joomla Extension Installer - the site connects automatically once the plugin is active.

## **What happens if I get a connection error when adding my site?**

mySites.guru provides a manual connection option where you enter your domain name to retry, and the support team will investigate all connection issues for free.
